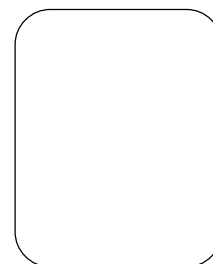

Kerala State Chalachitra Academy invites applications for its Part time Fellowship Programme. Five fellowships for a period of one year are offered with a total stipend of Rs. 18,000/- . The fellowship programme is aimed at the publication of authentic studies on **Economics of Malayalam Film Industry**. Graduates having aptitude in writing may apply. In case of candidates having a record of excellence in the field of film studies the above conditions may be relaxed. Application along with rules and regulations will be available at the Academy office, Sasthamangalam from 24th August 2009 on payment of Rs. 50/- by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of The Secretary, Kerala State Chalachitra Academy. Last date of submission is 24th September 2009.

Theme : This year's Kerala State Chalachitra Academy Fellowship Programme will be research/ documentation work relating to the theme : The Economics of Malayalam Film Industry. The researcher/fellow can take up any aspect of the Economics of Malayalam Film Industry like :

- ◆ History of Production
- ◆ History of Distribution
- ◆ History of Exhibition.
- ◆ Trends in Budget Allocation.
- ◆ Economic History of Malayalam Film Industry.
- ◆ Technological Changes in Production, Distribution and Exhibition.
- ◆ Aesthetics in Co-relation with Economic of Cinema.
- ◆ Issues of Piracy.
- ◆ Socio Economic History of theatre and Talkies in Kerala.
- ◆ Narratives of Producers, Distributors and Exhibitors.

How to Apply : Interested scholars are requested to send, along with the application, a synopsis of 1000 words of the topic they would like to study, along with a brief note on methodology.

The applicants should also send copies of their earlier works in the field of film studies, documentation and criticism, in the form of articles, books, web content or CD ROMs.

The proposals would be examined by a panel of experts and the applicants would be called for an interview. A maximum of five scholars will be selected.

Period of Fellowship : One Year.

Fellowship : Five part-time fellowships are offered. The scholar will be expected to write in English or Malayalam a minimum 75 foolscap typed pages researched document with bibliography and references on the selected subject. Two copies and a soft copy will have to be submitted. Each person will be assigned a guide by Kerala State Chalachitra Academy. The guide will offer consultation as well as monitor the progress of the project. The grant will be released in three installments. The final installment will be paid on submission of approved project. An allowance of Rs. 10,000/- will be granted for journeys undertaken for purposes of the fellowship programme, purchase of books & other supporting material. These will be reimbursed on production of bills etc. counter signed by the guide. Books etc. purchased will be the property of Chalachitra Academy. A contract will be signed between Kerala State Chalachitra Academy and the fellow stating terms and conditions. Copyright of the work will rest with the Academy.

Preliminary Seminar : A preliminary report of the study should be submitted within three months of the fellowship. The fellows will also have to make a presentation of the same in a Seminar organised specifically for this purpose by KSCA. Film writers, scholars and filmmakers will participate in the seminar, to discuss the papers and to make suggestions.

Publication : An expert committee will examine the research projects and recommend for publication. Terms & conditions of publication will be worked out separately with the author in case the work is selected for publication.
